LUNDER 2018 ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES

Minutes Pending Approval

January 20, 2019

The 2019 Lunder Annual Meeting was called to order on Sunday, January 20, 2019 at 11:25 AM by President Doug Krueger. The meeting was held in the Lunder Sanctuary. Pastor Randy Baldwin opened the meeting by reading the message from Bishop Eaton. The Litany was read by Pastor Randy and the congregation responded as indicated. The Secretary's report was read. There was a motion by Roger Larson to approve the minutes, seconded by Meri Bauers. The motion was voted on and it passed to accept the minutes as read.

The Treasurer's report was read. It was discussed that the amount for lawn mowing/snow removal was incorrect on the report for the amount that Lunder Church actually pays. It was reported as \$1040, but this was before the Lunder Cemetery Association paid their portion. So, the actual amount that the Lunder church paid for lawn mowing services for 2018 was \$346.67 (1/3 of the \$1040 amount) with the association paying \$693.33 (2/3 of the \$1040 amount). It was noted to ask the treasurer if, at the end of the year, the total amount for lawn mowing/snow removal for the year could be sent to the cemetery association sooner, so they could pay their share and report it before the next year's budget report was printed to avoid confusion. President Krueger discussed our budget changes with a new plan for the garbage disposal (no more cart pickup – using the orange Thompson Sanitation bags pickup system instead) and the cancelling of our Plunkett's Pest control account (trying our own pest control initiative). It was noted to please notify a council member if you notice any difficulties with either of these changes to Lunder's maintenance routine. A motion was made by Guy Overland, seconded by Herman Bauers to accept the Treasurer's report as read. The motion was voted on and was passed.

Pastor Randy went over his Pastor's report. He discussed the many changes over the years with One in Christ's

membership and the possibility of Bethany joining One in Christ. He noted that it would need a 66% approval by the congregations if talks did indeed proceed to a vote, but that there was much work to be done before that part would be taking place.

The Lunder Bible Study Group report was included in the annual meeting booklet – President Doug Krueger noted the name change for the group and invited any men who were interested in attending to join them at Bible Study.

The Lunder Cemetery Association report was referenced and was available in the annual meeting booklet. Herman Bauers noted that the Association gave half of its gift from the Maxine Gavle estate (\$6,000) to the Lunder Lutheran Church (gift of \$3,000).

Old Business – President Krueger reminded those attending of the ability to sign up for electronic giving and to contact Connie Kabrud for the forms and assistance in getting it set up. **New Business** – the budget was gone over with little discussion needed. Roger Larson made a motion to accept the budget and Barb Soper seconded it. The motion passed.

The listing for church roles in 2019 are as follows: Tracie Roberts, Connie Kabrud, Lynda Vis and Sarah Flugum (Treasurer) will stay on with Council and Roger Larson and Melissa Schmidt have volunteered to be added to Council for a 2 year term. Roger Larson will be coming off the One in Christ Parish Council, so we need a person to be nominated to serve with Beth Isaacson on the Once in Christ Parish Council. There were no volunteers or nominations, so a person will need to be appointed by the council at our next meeting. The Cemetery Committee will include Dale Overland, Jeff Bauers and Herman Bauers. The Cemetery Custodian will be Brody Larson of Larson Services. Head Usher is Herman Bauers and our Sexton is Dale Overland. The Grounds Committee is Richard Roberts and Roger Larson. Sunday School Coordinators are Beth Isaacson and Amy Wadding. Board of Education is Shar Rickert, Sandi Oudekerk and Melissa Schmidt. St. John's representatives are Pastor Randy and Pastor Bill. Our Thrivent Coordinator is Carol Kallberg and our Special Serving Committee is Debbie Madsen and Sandi Oudekerk. Synod Assembly delegates to be determined. Meri Bauers made a motion to cast an unanimous ballot for the positions above and Connie Kabrud seconded the motion. A vote was taken and it passed.

A motion was made by Jason Isaacson to end the meeting and Herman Bauers seconded the motion – the congregation voted to pass and the meeting was adjourned at 11:57 AM.
