### Silver Lake Annual Meeting - 1/27/19

*Minutes Pending Approval*

President Bill Loberg called the meeting to order.

Secretary's report from last year's annual meeting was read.

Jean Hrubetz made a motion and Jeannie Loberg 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion to accept the report. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report from last year's annual meeting was given.

Larry Johnson made a motion and Denny Reyerson 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion to accept the report. Motion carried.

**Old Business: Air conditioning:** The grant request has been submitted and we are now waiting for an approval.

**New Business: Better Heating system in Narthex:** Beulah Thompson requested that we look into a better system for heat in the Narthex. The council will look into options and report back to the congregation.

**Sidewalk repair:** The council is in discussion to replace the sidewalks. A handicap sidewalk with better parking has also been discussed. This would be done as a grant through the WCDA.

**Budget:** After review Dennis Kreuzer made a motion and Bonnie Maher 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion to accept the Silver Lake Lutheran Church Budget. Motion carried.

**Nominations: Church council members:** Joan Vorland, Bill Loberg and Denny Reyerson terms have expired. Bill Loberg said he would go on for another term, Gus Hagen volunteered. Brian Nelson made a motion and Dennis Kreuzer 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion to nominate Orville Quam. Motion carried.

**Parish Council:** Dennis Kreuzer made a motion and Larry Johnson 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion to nominate Bonnie Maher for the Parish Council. Motion carried.

**Lutheran Retirement Home Representative:** Larry Johnson made a motion and Dennis Reyerson 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion to nominate Brian Nelson. Motion carried.

**Synod assembly delegates:** The synod assembly is in Waverly, June 14<sup>th</sup> through the 16<sup>th</sup>. Representatives will be nominated at a later date.

**Other Business:** Bonnie Maher gave a report on the Endowment Fund. After discussion, Denny Reyerson made a motion and Brian Nelson 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion to accept the report. Motion carried.

### Silver Lake Council Minutes - February 19, 2019

*Minutes Pending Approval*

6 people were in attendance: Enos Loberg, Larry Johnson,

The Treasurer's Report was given by Bill Loberg. The general balance was \$16,406.45 and after review of the bills, Enos made a motion and Larry 2<sup>nd</sup> to accept the report and approve the bills. Motion carried.

The Secretary's Report was read. Enos made the motion and Larry 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion to accept the report.

**Old Business:** 1. Air Conditioning: Grand application was submitted. Grants are accepted on April 15<sup>th</sup>.

2. New Thermostats: waiting for opportune time to be installed
3. Electronic Sign: On hold until weather would permit installation.

**Other:** 1. Thank you note from Pastor Randy and Bonnie Kay for Christmas gift was read and acknowledged. Thank you note from Helen Steene was read and acknowledged.

2. Bill Loberg was welcomed back into the council and Orval Quam and Gus Hagen were welcomed as new Silver Lake Council members.
3. Bill Loberg was nominated for Silver Lake Council president and accepted. Carol Bergo was nominated for Silver Lake Council secretary and accepted. Enos made a motion and Larry 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion to accept the nominations. Motion carried.

**Church Attendance Concerns:** 1. Will try starting a "Silver Lake Congregational Social Outing". This would be a get together following church services at varying restaurants on Communion Sunday of each month. Larry will follow-up with this.

2. Enos will talk with Denny to see if the Northwood Anchor was contacted about how the One In Christ Church listing is printed in the paper. To see if it can be easier to read.
3. Will start making personal contact with inactive members. Carrol to get list from Sandy.
4. Discussed hymn selection as a possible change to bring in the younger members.

**New Business:** 1. Of the 4 heaters in the foyer the 1 heater on the NW side does not work. Larry Johnson will look into the controls to see if this could be replaced.

2. Yard light on church is not working. On hold until weather permits investigation into issue.
3. Micro phone is not working correctly. Bill Loberg will contact Ron Christianson for possible input.
4. A bid for \$1,068.60 was submitted by Larry Johnson from Groe Electric Inc. to replace fans in the church. (Labor - \$780.00; 2 Kichler 52" fans \$288.60) Orval made a motion to accept the bid and Larry 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Motion carried.
5. A bid of \$2,283.83 was submitted by Enos Loberg from Loberg Construction for a ramp with 6' railing and sidewalk repair leading into the church. Larry made the motion and Carol 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion to accept the bid. Motion carried.
6. Discussion on bringing the fans and sidewalk repair to the attention of the congregation to see any members wish to donate towards the building fund.
7. Lenten service meal donations. Bill Loberg will find out from Mary Mehus about the meal at Silver Lake on March 13<sup>th</sup>. It has been suggested the meal donations go to any youth from Silver Lake Church who attend the Youth Service Trip to Savannah, Georgia, July 19 – 28.

Next Council meeting will be at 7:00 pm – March 19<sup>th</sup> at Immanuel

Enos made a motion and Larry 2<sup>nd</sup> it to adjourn the meeting. Motion carried. We closed with The Lord's Prayer.
