Minutes Pending Approval

April 16, 2019

People in attendance: Kathy Kreuzscher, Larry Johnson, Carol Bergo, Bill Loberg, & Orval Quam.

The Treasurer's Report was given by Kathy Kreuzscher.

The general balance was \$20752.87. Motion to accept the report was made and seconded. Motion carried.

The Secretary's Report was read. Motion to accept the report was made and seconded. Motion carried.

Old Business:

- 1) Air Conditioning: Grant application was accepted and \$8840.00 has been granted. Larry Johnson will contact Young Plumbing and Heating to start the project.
- 2) Electronic Sign: On hold until weather would permit installation.
- 3) Yard light on church is not working. Ballast was replaced but this did not solve the issue. Bill Loberg will replace the bulb when possible.
- 4) Of the 4 heaters in the foyer the 1 heater on the NW side does not work. Larry Johnson will look into the controls to see if this could be replaced. It was determined the non-functioning heater needed to be rewired. It has been sent to the electrician, Danny DeVries, to be rewired.
- 5) Loberg Construction will start work on building a ramp with 6' railing and doing sidewalk repair leading into the church in the 2nd week of May. Anti-slip pads will be added to cement on the ramp to address concerns about slipping.
- 6) It was decided since no youth from Silver Lake will be attending the Youth Service Trip this summer the donations for the Lenten service meal will be split 50% going for Flood Buckets and 50% going for community gardens.

CHURCH ATTENDANCE CONCERNS:

- 1) "Silver Lake May Fellowship Event" will be held on Sunday, May 5th at the Pizza Ranch in Albert Lea. All are invited to attend.
- 2) Enos to talk with Denny to see if the Northwood Anchor was contacted about how One in Christ Lutheran Parish listing is printed in the paper. To see if it can be made easier to read.
- 3) Will start making personal contact with inactive members. Copy of members was distributed to council members interested in reaching out.

New Business:

- 1) On the wall where the water was leaking into the basement the outside needs to be re-sloped and plastic applied.
- 2) Easter Breakfast donations will go to the Sunday School.
- 3) Bill Loberg will organize the Memorial Day Flags. He will address any flags needing to be replaced.
- 4) Lawn mowing has been arranged with Peterson Lawn Service from Lake Mills.

5) Bill Loberg will check on fire extinguishers and fire alarm for church. Insurance company already has sensors in place for flooding and power outage.

6) A new date needs to be set up for more tree trimming. Next Council meeting will be at 7:00 pm – May 21 at Silver Lake.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made and seconded.

Motion carried. We closed with the Lord's Prayer.
