**LUNDER BIBLE STUDY GROUP STEWARDSHIP
Albert Lea School's Adult Learning Center (ALC)**

This spring the Lunder Bible Study Group is asking for the Congregation's help with our stewardship project. We will be collecting items for ALC. The ALC provides free adult basic education including English as a second language, math, GED preparation and testing, citizenship, and basic skills. Many of the students at the ALC are people from other countries with limited income who have come to call the Albert Lea area home. At this time 11 different languages are spoken. Students range in age from 16 to 75+ and in the past year over 210 students have been served.

During their learning experiences at ALC, students earn ABE (*adult basic education) "bucks" for every day they attend class. These bucks in turn can be used to purchase items in the center's "store". The students can shop in the store for items useful in their everyday home life. It is these items that we hope to help the ALC replenish. *Suggestions include (all items new please):* laundry soap, dish soap, bath soap, toothpaste, toothbrushes, deodorant, feminine hygiene products, paper towels, toilet paper, cleaning supplies of all kinds, bath towels, washcloths. *Acceptable used items include:* clean infant and children's clothing, dishes, and small appliances in good working condition (i.e. toaster, iron, coffeemaker, mixer, etc). Food times are discouraged as they do not get used as regularly.
