SCAM ALERT

From the office of the Northeastern Iowa Synod...

One of our pastors has reported that several members of the congregation she is serving received text messages that claimed to be from her. The texts did not come from her phone, but each text addressed the member by name, and was signed using "Pastor" followed by her full name. The text stated that she was at the hospital and visiting two cancer patients. These patients needed help and, since she was busy, could they go to the store and buy 2 eBay gift cards for \$100 each. The scammer asked her to take a photo of the bar code on each card and text the photos. Police have been notified, as well as other members of the congregation.

It is unknown how the scammers accessed the member information. The texts did not come from the pastor's phone.. These scammers take advantage of the generous nature of people. Now they are doing it by taking advantage of, and abusing, the relationship between pastor/deacon/lay minister and people.

We do not and will not ask for assistance from anyone in this manner!
