People in attendance: Kathy Kreuzscher, Larry Johnson, Carol Bergo, Bill Loberg, Gus Hagen, & Orval Quam

The Treasurer's report was given by Kathy Kreuzscher. Motion to accept the report was made and seconded. Motion carried.

The Secretary report was read. Motion to accept the report was made and seconded. Motion carried.

**Old Business:**

1. Installation of Air Conditioning is complete.
2. Electronic Sign: Electrical line has to be found and determine what needs to be done.
3. Larry Johnson is working with the electrician to complete the work on the heater in the Foyer.
4. Loberg Construction will work on building a ramp with 6' railing and doing sidewalk repair leading into the church as weather and time permits. Anti-slip pads will be added to cement on the ramp to address concerns about slipping.
5. As weather and events permit the outside of the basement wall will have plastic applied and be re-sloped to prevent water leakage.
6. Bill Loberg will organize putting up the Memorial Day Flags and will address and needing to be replaced.
7. Tree trimming has been completed. Checking into tree removal service for tree interfering with the septic tank.
8. The insurance company covering the church is developing a fire alarm for rural churches. Fire extinguishers have been checked and are up to date.

**Church attendance concerns:**

1. "Silver Lake June Fellowship Event" will be held on Sunday, June 2<sup>nd</sup> at the China Restaurant in Albert Lea. All are invited to attend.
2. Still need to contact the Northwood Anchor about how the One In Christ Church listing is printed in the paper. To see if it can be made easier to read.

**New Business:**

1. Discussion was held on Silver Lake's contribution of \$200 for the Northeastern Iowa Synod. Motion to do the contribution was made and seconded. Motion carried.
2. Discussion was held about applying for a grant from the WCDA for another solar panel. Bill Loberg will start gathering required information to apply.

3. Discussion was held about mapping out parking for cars. It was noted if handicap parking is designated the rest of the parking lot will need to be mapped out for parking at that time.

Next Council meeting will be held at 7:00 pm Tuesday, June 18<sup>th</sup> at Immanuel.

Motion to adjourn the meeting was made and seconded. Motion carried. We closed with The Lord's Prayer.

**Old Business**

Denny Reyerson reported that the Diamond Window repair is under way by Phil Cooper and will continue when the lift truck is repaired.

A review of the Flood Bucket was done and will procure enough to complete 1 Bucket.

**New Business**

A tour of Silver Lake was conducted by members of the council and found that water may be infiltrating our education centers foundation.

Covering the window wells plastic moldings and re leveling the grade at the foundation may direct the water away!

Basement walls in the education center will be repaired after the water is diverted.

The back door and window need repair and flashing.

Phil Cooper will be asked to install the new parking lot light and to investigate the roof of the Gudvangen addition to look for water leaks.

A request for a \$100.00 donation to the Synod assembly was presented and approved by all.

A bid from Sun Rack Solar was received and an offer of a charitable donation in the amount of \$690.00 from them keeps our costs under \$10,000.00. A congregational vote was scheduled for June 4th to approve the project

Our next meeting will be June 25<sup>th</sup> following Sunday services as Pastor Randy will be on vacation.

Adjournment was called for and approved by all.
