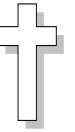

Winnebago Giving Opportunities

Winnebago's budget is divided into three primary parts:

General fund – covers the overall operating expenses of Winnebago Lutheran Church which includes salaries, utilities, upkeep and program expenses. A budget is developed to serve as a guide to how money can be spent and so the congregation knows what will be needed. No money from the general fund is given to the synod or ELCA.

Benevolence – this includes a number of areas that are given to specifically – General mission support (Northeastern Iowa Synod and ELCA), Lutheran Services of Iowa (Bremwood and Beloit are part of this), World Hunger Appeal, Missionary, Disaster Relief, and Local benevolences (food bank, local ministerial who help with hardship situations, etc.). All of these areas must be designated specifically in your giving. The congregation annually sets goals we try to reach in these areas.

Building/Property – We currently do not have any specific projects in the works, but there always will be building upkeep and repairs.

There are other giving opportunities that are more unique such as special offerings (*disaster relief, etc.*), memorials (*gift designated*) and the estate fund (*governed by the guidelines the congregation adopted*).

One can respond to Winnebago's budget with what some refer to as a "three-pocket" giving. Any gift so-designated will go to that area of ministry – general fund, specified benevolence, and/or building.

If a gift is undesignated, it will go to the general fund.

There are some exceptions to this. On the following days – (These are colored envelopes in your offering box) Christmas, Lenten (*offering sometimes has a specific designation*), Easter, Pentecost, and Mission Sunday – the loose and non-designated offering goes to mission support (*Northeastern Iowa Synod and the ELCA*) unless you designate it to a specific area of benevolence.

We ask (*please*) that gifts are not given to a designated fund that has not been pre-approved by the congregational council.
