Minutes Pending Approval

Sunday, January 20, 2019

Council President, Michael Johnson, called the meeting to order. Pastor Peters opened the meeting with devotions. The motion to approve the agenda was made, seconded and approved. The following items were discussed:

Secretary's report: The secretary's report for 2018 annual meeting was reviewed and approved as read.

Auditing Committee Report: Brian Knudtson and Vickie Thompson met with Treasurer Nancy Johnson to review the books for 2017. Everything was in order. Brian highlighted how good the year was financially. The motion was made to approve the auditing committee's report. M/S/C.

Treasurer's Report: Nancy Johnson, treasurer, reviewed the year-end figures for operating expenses, benevolence giving, and funds for the 2018 year. Nancy highlighted, we put in a new sidewalk, received a new lawn mower, fixed the well pump, and got a new organ. All is paid for and we have a general fund balance of \$14453.00. It was a good year. It was M/S/C. to approve.

Pastor's Report: Pastor Peter's thanked the members of Winnebago for the sharing their time, talents, giving and support in the past year.

One in Christ Parish Report: Rich Lindflott highlighted we have been a parish for 15 years. We will start the conversation with Thompson's Lutheran Church to join the parish. Pastor Bill highlighted that the parish gave another \$19,497 for benevolences in 2018.

Cemetery Report: Mark Kingland presented the cemetery report for 2018. M/ S/C to accept the report.

Nominating Report: Becky Solomonson thanked everyone who said yes to serve.

Old Business: None

New Business: The presentation of the ballot was made by Michael Johnson. A motion was made and seconded to accept the ballot as presented. Motion Carried.

Winnebago Estate and Gift Fund: We received \$5658.72 in estate gifts this year. 10% of that fund is \$565.80. The interest on the Mission investment account is \$269.44. The total amount to give away is \$845.24. The council suggested the money be given to Lutheran Social Services of Iowa. It was M/S/C.

Winnebago Congregation Budget 2019: Michael Johnson, President, presented the proposed 2019 budget as recommended by the council. He highlighted the insurance cost has gone up for 2019 and the repairs should be less this year. It was M/S/C to approve the budget.
