Summer Food Service Program

“Summer Food and Fun”

First serving day...Monday, June 1st

First Day OIC is serving – June 4th

*Some changes to this program – the youth will pick
up their meals at Salem (at least through June)
between 11:00 am & 12:00 pm (noon).*

The Summer Food Service Program was established to ensure that all children continue to receive nutritious meals when school is not in session. These free meals meet Federal nutrition guidelines and are provided to all children in qualifying areas.

LMAMA – Lake Mills Area Ministerial Association – is the sponsoring organization and area churches and organizations have volunteered to help serve meals in the past years– Asbury, Salem, One in Christ, Word of Faith, and a variety of community organizations have helped. We have a cook and site supervisor hired.

The program is fully funded by a reimbursement for the State of Iowa. All children/youth – infant thru 18 years can eat at the distribution site for free. Salem Lutheran (June) will be the distribution sites in Lake Mills.

Volunteers Needed starting at 10:30 am – distribute food and manage the site – **One In Christ is again taking Thursdays. Call the parish office if you are willing to help.**

PASTOR BILL IS HOME

Pastor Bill is home recovering. Please keep him in your prayers as he gets his strength back.

Background: I had a heart block (not blockage) which means my heart’s electrical system failed. Sunday, May 3rd, my heart temporarily stopped multiple times which felt like fainting spells. I was fitted with an external pacemaker for the trip to Rochester where they immediately put in a temporary pacemaker. Two days later they put in a permanent pacemaker, my body did not receive it well and an hour or so after the procedure the pacemaker failed and my heart stopped completely. After a few minutes I was revived with CPR and other means. Due to the stoppage, some of my other organs/systems have been compromised and recovering.

Today I feel well, but I have no stamina. So I and my efforts are slow, that will get better and I will work my way back into the flow of things. I have a few limitations. Due to the insertion of the pacemaker, I have limited use of my arm for 4-5 weeks. Because I passed out, I cannot drive for 6 months.

The most pressing concern and limitation is that the aggressive drug regiment being used to combat sarcoidosis (heart disease at the root of this) will eliminate my immune system while on these drugs – thru August. I’m high risk for anything infectious. I will be wearing a mask and goggles of some sort when I’m around others. **And I ask that you wear a mask and avoid contact and honor the social distancing guidelines when I’m around.**

Thank you. I have been grateful and humbled by your prayers and concerns. Thank you for the cards and messages – they often came at just the needed time. Thank you to those who generously brought food and have offered to do various tasks. Thank you to all those who have stepped in and stepped up to fill in for what has needed to get done. Thank you for continuing to honor me as part of your family.
