5. Silver Lake Lutheran Church's status as a non-profit has expired. Bill Loberg contacted John Greve, who wrote up Articles of Incorporation for the Silver Lake Lutheran Church and these have been presented to the state. **Waiting to hear back on this from the state?**

1. "Silver Lake June Fellowship Event" has been put on hold until further notice because of the Coronavirus restrictions.
2. There has been very positive feedback on the current broadcasting of the One In Christ Church services. The One In Christ council is looking into how to continue this after regular church services resume.
3. Suggestion was made for each church member to extend an invitation to another individual to watch the broadcast of the services.

### New Business:
