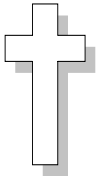

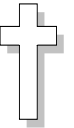

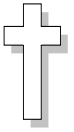

Minutes Pending Approval

June 16, 2020

New Business:

Re-opening plan- customize for Winnebago. Barb Able representing One in Christ- Board suggestions on how to move forward with re-opening.

We will get information on technical ways to worship with offering the information on a large screen for service to eliminate papers being handled for announcements and worship and music. There are funds available from a memorial that was designated to use for technical upgrades. We are going to research the best way to utilize these funds and help our worship services going forward.

It will be required that everyone wear a mask during worship. We will offer hand sanitizer, masks, and taking attendance as people come to church. We also have someone volunteering to make masks and donating them in case people forget to bring one that they will be able to keep. We will have limited use of the church to help control how much cleaning will need to be done from week to week.

Winnebago Church council – made a re-opening plan. We will meet early July to prepare for the opening of our church and the procedures we put in place to allow to do it safely and to have the guidelines in place before July 19th. If the council feels we are still at too high a risk we might move to wait reopening Winnebago Church at that time. We will have a letter sent out to all of our members explaining the process for re-opening with the changes implemented to keep our congregation safe. There will also be information in the newsletter.
