## WORSHIP NOTES

**Masking** – All are to mask in the church  
5 yr old's & younger do not need to mask  
– parent's discretion

### Holy Communion – October 4<sup>th</sup>

- Wine will be in a condominium cup w/lid and wafer in plastic bag. The elements will be on a table in the narthex,
- Pick up cup/wine and bag/wafer when entering the sanctuary.
- Communion will be in the pews.
- Everything would be handled and set out with gloves.
- This would allow us to social distance and minimize handling everything.
- Wear masks except when consuming the elements.

### Sunday School Christmas Program

These are conversations concerning the gathering of youth (practicing and program) and of congregation – not being able to social distance.

- Limiting the people in the sanctuary
- Limiting seats/ tickets per child/family
- Reservations prior to program

### Christmas Eve Worship

These are conversations concerning how to handle the number of people attending – not being able to social distance.

- Two Christmas Eve worships – suggested 4:00 and 8:00 pm – time for cleaning and Bethany worship between worships
- Reservations for worship – limited number of people per worship.
- Music/Singing – little or no singing, special music – piano, organ, soloist and small singing groups, recorded/video songs by adults, children, families, recorded music from SS Christmas Program
