VOTED TO UPGRADE TECHNOLOGY

It was decided to add cameras, screens, other necessary electronics in the sanctuary to enhance our ability to “live stream” our worship and to enable us to put much of our worship on a screen. The cost of this project will \$17,000. We have a memorial (Archie Monson) \$10,000 designated for this project.

We are asking for \$7,000 of donations over two weeks to cover the balance. After one week we have \$ 4,950 in donations towards our goal.
