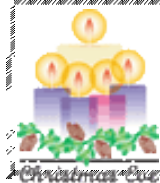

## Silver Lake Congregational Meeting Minutes

*Minutes Pending Approval*

**November 15, 2020**

A call to order of a congregational meeting of the Silver Lake Lutheran Church was made by Bill Loberg, president of the Silver Lake Lutheran Council, at 10:15 AM November 15, 2020.

Bill Loberg provided a review of the proposed 2021 One In Christ Lutheran Parish budget. He gave an overview of what the change would be from the 2020 budget.

A motion to approve the 2021 proposed One In Christ Lutheran Parish budget was made by Bonnie Maher and seconded by Lorraine Morris. A congregational vote was held and passed unanimously by all those in attendance.

Dennis Kreuzscher brought to the attention of the congregation that members with a donation could have the broadcast of the "One in Christ" Church services given in memory of loved ones to help offset the cost of the videographer. This would not be available until January 2021.

Melanie DeVries told the congregation there would not be a traditional Christmas program presented by the Sunday school this year at Silver Lake. She would be checking into the students participating in the Christmas service in some way with Pastor Randy.

The meeting adjourned.

## Silver Lake Lutheran Church Council Minutes

*Minutes Pending Approval*

**November 17, 2020**

Conference call was initiated by Pastor Randy at 7:40 PM. Started with a prayer from Pastor Randy. He then gave the One In Christ Report and his own report. Call to order was made by Bill Loberg. Those on the call were Carol Bergo – Secretary, Larry Johnson, Gus Hagen, Orval Quam, and Kathy Kreuzscher – Treasurer.

The Secretary's Report was given by Carol. Motion was made to accept the report, motion was seconded, and approved by all in attendance.

The Treasurer's Report was presented by Kathy Kreuzscher. Motion was made to accept the report, motion was seconded, and approved by all in attendance.

## Old Business:

1. **Update on Steeple trim needing to be painted:** Bill Loberg will continue to look for a lift which will reach. This cannot be addressed until next spring/summer.
2. **Update on boiler in church parsonage:** Boiler had to be replaced it was beyond repair. This was completed at a cost of \$7,800. Council discussed the cost and decided this was a necessary maintenance item to the church property and funds should come from the Gudvangen Fund. Motion was made, seconded, and approved by the majority of the council.
3. **Mission Sunday was held on November 15<sup>th</sup>.** At Silver Lake the offering went to Day Spring and the Northwood Food Shelf.
4. **Sunday, Nov 15<sup>th</sup> church congregational meeting:** Bill Loberg presented the proposed budget for 2021 for the "One In Christ Lutheran Parish". A motion was made and seconded to accept the proposal. All those present voted to accept the 2021 One In Christ Lutheran Parish budget. Motion carried.
5. **Stained glass window behind pastor's chair:** Donny Thompson gave ideas about addressing this and will give a quote. It cannot be done until next spring/summer. There are 2 windows are involved. It was suggested that an angled piece of plexiglass be put over both windows. There is an electrical line in the way which will need to be addressed.
6. **Basement wall under the on window which is showing a great deal of water damage:** Prior to getting this fixed it needs to be determined if filling in the window wells and landscaping around the basement walls to run water away addresses the issue which is causing the water damage.
7. **On the broadcasting of the "One In Christ" Church services being given in memory of loved ones:** One In Christ Parish Council approved this. After December meeting the council will have the information on when this will start and what the donation amount will be.

## Other:

1. One In Christ is still looking for a backup Videographer for church services.
2. On November 1<sup>st</sup> at church service quiet singing with masks on started. When Pastor Bill is doing the service this will not be possible.

  3. 1<sup>st</sup> Communion has been moved to December 6<sup>th</sup>. Currently there is no one at Silver Lake who will be taking First Communion.
  4. Ter will not be a traditional Christmas program by the Silver Lake Sunday School this year. Melanie DeVries will work with Pastor Randy on having the students participate in the Christmas Service in some way.
  5. Confirmation classes will be online starting Wednesday, November 18<sup>th</sup> probably lasting thru Christmas break.
  6. It was mentioned that Bill Loberg’s, Gus Hagen’s, and Orval Quam’s terms on the church council will be up in January and we need to start looking for parishioners who would be willing to serve

- Motion to adjourn the meeting was made and seconded.
