Old Business:

1. **Update on the Steeple trim needing to be painted:** Trying to find someone to give an estimate. This cannot be addressed until next spring/summer.
2. **Stained glass window behind pastor's chair:** Donny Thompson gave ideas about addressing this and will give a quote. It cannot be done until next spring/summer.
3. **Basement wall under the one window which is showing a great deal of water damage:** Prior to getting this fixed need to determine if filling in the window wells and landscaping around the basement walls to run water away addresses the issue. This will be addressed in the spring.

Other:

1. One in Christ is still looking for a backup Videographer for church services.
