Old Business

- 1) Bethany members have been working through the "honey do" lists that were provided by the council.
- 2) A radio has been purchased for the kitchen to enable servers in the kitchen to use and be able listen to the services taken place at the same time.
- 3) Judy presented information other churches in North Iowa are using to assist with self-run funerals, when no funeral planner is used, and the charges that the church may charge.
