A call to order of the congregational meeting of
the Silver Lake Lutheran Church was made
by Larry Johnson, president of the Silver
Lake Lutheran Council, at 11:55 AM,
November 21, 2021.

Larry provided an overview of the proposed
2022 One In Christ Lutheran Parish budget.
He noted the 4.55% increase from 2021 to
2022. Pastor Randy Baldwin explained to the
congregation the CCC numbers used for the
2021 budget were used to determine each
congregation's prorated expense for the 2022
budget.

A motion to approve the 2022 proposed One In
Christ Lutheran Parish budget was made by
Clair Hengesteg and seconded by Dennis
Reyerson.

A congregational vote was held and passed
unanimously by all those in attendance.
There were 23 CCC Silver Lake members in
attendance.

Bonnie Maher brought to the congregation's

her on the council.
