#### **CONGREGATIONAL STEWARDSHIP PROJECT**

#### **Albert Lea School's Adult Basic Education (ABE)**

Once again we will be collecting items for ABE. They very much appreciated our help last year!

The ABE provides free adult basic education including English as a second language, math, GED preparation and testing, citizenship preparation, and basic skills. ABE serves students from the ages of 16 – 75, speaking 11 different languages, and often have limited income as they strive to make Albert Lea home.

During their learning experiences at ABE, students earn ABE “bucks” for every day they attend class. These bucks can be used to purchase items in the center’s “store” – everyday household item.

We are collecting items to provide for their “store”. Suggestions include “new” items please:

Kleenex, laundry soap, dish soap, bar soap, toothpaste, hand lotion, hair shampoo, Germ X hand sanitizer, Cling Wrap, toilet paper, cleaning supplies of all kinds, bath towels, kitchen towels, blankets, salt, ketchup, oil, tomato soup, beans, Asian noodles, long grain white rice, macaroni, peas, tomato juice, pasta, chicken noodle soup, socks (adult & children), dresses, baby T-shirts, adult underwear.
