CONGREGATIONAL STEWARDSHIP PROJECT

Lutheran World Relief Personal Care Kits

Lunder Bible Study group will be collecting items for Lutheran World Relief this fall and the group is asking for help from our congregation. We hope to make Personal Care Kits for the LWR spring van that comes to First Lutheran, Albert Lea. Last year we were able to complete 18 kits along with 4 fabric kits, with help from the Sunday School in putting the kits together for packing. These kits are sent to Africa, Asia, Latin America, the Middle East, and recently to Ukraine, to help in countries where the need is the greatest, where people are struggling with poverty and hunger, and trying to find health care or education. Items needed for the kits include 1. Lightweight bath towels (dark colors recommended) 2. Bath size bars of soap (about 3-4 oz each) 3. Adult toothbrushes 4. Sturdy combs 5. Metal nail clippers. Shopping lists for the kits are available in the church narthex along with a bin for collecting items. Any item will be of great help. Thrivent Action Team money will also be requested to help reaching our goal, which is to exceed the number of kits from last year! We will be collecting supplies until the **end of December**. In early January, the Sunday School will be packing the kits for us!
